The history of Lecuyer's dates back to Europe and the spring of 1945. The end of World War II was near, and A. J. (Jim) Lecuyer was coming home soon. Jim sent what was the first of many overseas wires to the Ministry of Natural Resources. He wanted to build a summer tourist

camp on a beautiful piece of land that had a natural sand beach and the largest stand of giant white and red pines found anywhere in the entire area. He had saved his army pay and purchased the land. Jim and his new bride Mary had their first three log cabins built by the fall of 1946. That year they had three groups of guests. By the summer of '47, the secret of their special place was out. Fifteen groups of guests were hosted that summer . . . and the rest, as they say, is history . . .

Jim and Mary worked hard over the years, and had many visitors. Some were of a wild nature - including deer, timber wolves and a pet black bear. Jim had found the orphaned cub,



nursed and raised the animal (named Blackie)! One fall day, while Jim and Mary were away, Blackie broke into the root cellar, eating and destroying all of the canned provisions for the long, cold winter ahead. A hard decision and what a sight to see - a 400 lb. plus bear and Jim, putting down the lake in the old wooden boat, followed by a lengthy goodbye.

Mary traditionally planted a small flower bed from seedlings along the lakeshore. Although in great contrast with the wilderness, their brightness and beauty were a welcome sight indeed. She was an active partner in the camp and worked hard right alongside Jim.

Jim and Mary continued living their dream to its fullest. They raised a family of six children and added more cabins and a campground. They ran the camp with their son Dan until the untimely passing of Jim. Mary ran the camp for one more year and then sold it to her son. Dan now runs the camp with his children.

Jim Lecuyer did what few folks can say today - he lived his dream! We believe he is still with us in spirit, watching over us each day, sharing with us his wisdom and strength. We're really not sure what happened to old Blackie. Every time a bear is spotted, we can't help but wonder. Mary still visits her old friends at the camp and stops in frequently throughout the summer. Her dedication and willing smile won the hearts of everyone who met her. Over the years a good many changes have taken place, but the traditions of yesterday still remain.

very fortunate to be here and hope some day to be able to have my girls Leá and Amanda assume the responsibilities of running the lodge. Our goals for Lecuyer's Lodge have not changed. We want to make sure your experience with us is one you'll remember for years to come. For this reason, like my parents before, we are constantly updating and expanding our services and facilities for your comfort. We are resolute to provide great service, quality accommodations, newer equipment, fantastic meals and an extensive range of guest services. Trained, trustworthy, reliable and knowledgeable staff keep a positive attitude every day. We are proud of the fact that we are family built, owned and operated since 1946. While there are a good many resorts that have been around as long or longer, it is also true that they have seen a good many different owners over their history. We are in this for the long haul and we love what we do along with all the great guests we get to see each year. It goes without saying that having been in this business for so long, we know that if you are happy, you will refer us to your friends, family and business associates.

We've designed this brochure to tell you a little about Lecuyer's Tru-Tail Lodge, its facilities and its services. We do not intend this to take the place of personal correspondence but rather to provide you with some answers and to prepare you for your trip with us. For more information and reservations, I would be pleased to talk with you personally.

Nobody, but NOBODY, can hold a candle to the MUSKIE ACTION on Lake of the Woods. The guys from far to the north to the guys from the south, east *or* west. Lake of the Woods holds the largest concentration of both numbers and size.

And you'll be glad to know, it's not a fish of 10,000 casts on our lake. A true northwoods trophy. We have recorded releases to $57^{-1/2}$ " long. They must be 54" long to be a legal catch. This assures both good numbers and large fish in our lake. Last year alone we saw over 3 legals caught, several dozen in upper 40s, lower 50" range. All were released by fishermen with a modern day attitude and a better understanding of the fish itself. Just so they could fight again another day. MUSKIES . . . all other fish are just bait!

Routinely producing both in size and numbers. Great Northern Pike, with the average being in the 5-10 lb. range. True trophies, both taken and released up to 37 lbs. Fish need both the water and forage to become big. They also need the longer growing seasons - a norm on Lake of the Woods. The further north you go, the shorter the growing season. If you are looking for consistent Northern Pike fishing, and a great probability of catching that trophy, come fish with us. We have some real nice fish awaiting your arrival.

Excellent for sure! In the spring we catch them in very shallow water. Mid-summer they are suspended. Then in the late summer they start moving to deep holes. Average sizes from $^{3}/_{4}$ lb. to $1^{1}/_{4}$ lb., with Crappie up to $2^{3}/_{4}$ lb. taken each year. In the fall, the schools can be graphed - up to 100 yards long and 20 yards wide. They make for fantastic pan fishing and they are the tastiest treat to eat. Because of our fine structure, we can boast the finest Slab Crappie fishing anywhere.



Deep, cold water is what Lake Trout like. Just a 10 minute ride from the lodge, you'll find one of the finest, most beautiful trout lakes you'll ever want to fish.

Though this is the ONLY fish that we can't brag about catching more of and bigger than our friends further north, we do boast action in the 3-10 lb. range. Crow Lake is very deep and crystal clear with visibility of 25' or better. It's filled with lots of islands and reefs, although it is not as protected as Lake of the Woods. Best catches are in the early spring and late summer.

World class walleye found in Lake of the Woods

More and more anglers are discovering that Lake of the Woods is a great place to fish for walleye. So good, in fact, that two of the premier fishing magazines in the country have written special articles naming this area as a "world-class" fishery.

"A solid 5-pound 'eye (is) so common on Lake of the Woods these days that even a cooler full wouldn't get a second look."

The 1991 edition of "In-Fisherman's Walleye Guide" highlights this allstar lake as being one of the continent's hottest bites. The article focuses on eight lakes that are becoming renowned for fantastic numbers of good fish coupled with excellent numbers of trophies.

Lake of the Woods is the first lake featured in the article. "In-Fisherman's" magazine explains that the resurgence of the walleye population, credited by some of the ban on

commercial fishing, "rockets (Lake of the Woods) to a top spot on our numbers chart."

And the average size of fish in the lake has rocketed also. Since 1984, the average size of walleye taken has risen from one to two pounds. The Ministry of Natural Resources reports that "the number of three to fivepound walleye is on the upswing and that trophies of up to 14 pounds are within reason."

An article also appears in the March edition of "Peterson's Fishing" magazine. In that edition, a special section is given to the sport of walleye fishing with a special article on Lake of the Woods fishing.

In the article, it is mentioned that Lake of the Woods is perhaps the only "world-class" walleye fishing left in the world!

Come and find out for yourself what the pros are talking about!

Islands, shallow rocky shorelines, weedy back bays and hundreds of reefs. These are what make up our lake. They are also the favorite places for big bass to be. Lake of the Woods just doesn't have bass, it has EXCELLENT BASS'N. OUTSTANDING . . . with more structure and cover than anyone could ever fish. Smallmouth run in the 2-5 lb. range, with bass caught up to 7 lbs. just last year, very close to the lodge.

Our largemouth bass fishing just keeps getting better as well, ranging from 2-5 lbs. The largest caught this year was 7.9 lbs.! Let's see Florida grow'm that big with only the same length of growing season we have!

ACCOMMODATIONS

All our units have a beautiful lake view. Each hosts an outdoor deck. Complete with electric heat, hot water, four-piece baths, extra half bath in larger cabins. Complete full kitchens, auto coffee makers. Interiors are all knotty pine, each cabin has air conditioning. Truly above average for northwoods lodging.
